

The Announcement of Easter on the Epiphany of Our Lord

IN CATHEDRAL and other principal Churches, after the Gospel has been sung, the approaching Feast of Easter Sunday is solemnly announced to the people. This custom, which dates from the earliest ages of the Church, shows both the mysterious connection which unites the great Solemnities of the year one with another, and the importance the Faithful ought to attach to the celebration of that which is the greatest of all, and the center of all Religion. After having honored the King of the universe on the Epiphany, we shall have to celebrate him on the day which is now announced to us, as the conqueror of death.

On the seventeenth day of April we shall celebrate with joy the holy Pasch of our Lord Jesus Christ.


The twenty-sixth day of May will be the Ascension of our Lord Jesus Christ.
