

Proper Prayers of the Mass in the Extraordinary Form

August 8: St. Jean Marie Vianney, Confessor

(*Missa Pro Aliquibus Locis*, “Mass For Certain Places”)

Introit (Galatians 6:13; Psalm 30:2)

GOD FORBID that I should glory save in the Cross of our Lord Jesus Christ, by Whom the world is crucified to me and I to the world. *Psalm*. In Thee, O Lord, have I hoped, let me never be confounded; deliver me in Thy justice. Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Ghost. As it was in the beginning, is now, and ever shall be, world without end. Amen. — God forbid that I should glory ...

Collect

Almighty and merciful God, Who didst make Saint John Mary wonderful in his pastoral zeal and constant prayer and penance: grant, we beseech Thee, that by his example and intercession we may be able to win the souls of our brethren for Christ, and together with them attain to everlasting glory. Through the same Jesus Christ, Thy Son, our Lord: Who liveth and reigneth with Thee in the unity of the Holy Ghost, God, world without end.

Lesson (Ezcehiel 33 : 7, 10 – 12)

So thou, O son of man, I have made thee a watchman to the house of Israel; therefore thou shalt hear the word from my mouth, and shall tell it them from me. Thou, therefore, say to the house of Israel: Thus you have spoken, saying: Our iniquities and our sins are upon us, and we pine away in them; how then can we live? Say to them: As I live, saith the Lord God, I desire not the death of the wicked, but that the wicked turn from his way, and live. Turn ye, turn ye from your evil ways; and why will you die, O house of Israel? Thou, therefore, O son of man, say to the children of thy people: The wickedness of the wicked shall not hurt him in what day soever he shall turn from his wickedness.

Gradual (Psalm 44 : 2; Psalm 38 : 4)

My heart hath uttered a good word: I speak my works to the king. My heart grew hot within me, and in my meditation a fire will flame out.

Alleluia, alleluia. (Ecclesiasticus 48 : 1) He stood up as a fire, and his word burnt like a torch.
Alleluia.

Gospel (Matthew 9 : 35 – 38; 10 : 1)

At that time, Jesus went about all the cities and towns, teaching in their synagogues, and preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing every disease and every infirmity. And seeing the multitudes He had compassion on them; because they were distressed and lying like sheep that have no shepherd. Then He saith to His disciples: The harvest indeed is great, but the laborers are few. Pray ye therefore the lord of the harvest, that he send forth laborers into his harvest. And having called His twelve disciples together, He gave them power over unclean spirits, to cast them out, and to heal all manner of diseases, and all manner of infirmities.
